Palmer Catholic Academy Preschool, the preschool ministry of Our Lady Star of the Sea Catholic Church, was established in 1992 to provide parish families with a nurturing, Christ-centered environment where young children can learn, grow, and thrive. Conveniently located on the church grounds—just two miles south of J. Turner Butler Boulevard on A1A North in Ponte Vedra Beach— offering classes for ages 6 weeks through Pre-Kindergarten. Our developmentally focused programs are designed to foster independence, encourage creativity, and support healthy social interaction.

Our preschool is certified by the Florida Department of Children and Families and accredited by both the Florida Catholic Conference and the National Council for Private School Accreditation. Our dedicated staff includes degreed and certified teachers, supported by classroom assistants who help enrich learning experiences. In addition, all teachers complete catechist certification to prepare them for guiding students through the religious curriculum

We offer classes from August through May each year, including Voluntary Prekindergarten (VPK) for eligible four-year-old children. Our graduates consistently achieve high scores on the state’s kindergarten readiness assessments.

Families are encouraged to continue their seamless Catholic education by enrolling in Palmer Catholic Academy, located approximately three miles from the preschool on Palm Valley Road. Palmer Catholic Academy received the prestigious Blue Ribbon School Award in 2005 and ranks in the top tenth percentile nationally among private elementary schools for academic excellence. Currently enrolled preschool families and parishioners of Our Lady Star of the Sea Catholic Church receive priority during the academy’s registration process.

Philosophy of Education

In the preschool classrooms of Palmer Catholic Academy, our teachers and paraprofessionals encourage the natural curiosity of each child to learn about the world around them, in light of our Catholic faith. Our staff develops the whole child, in a Catholic and Christ centered educational environment. Our students learn in a play-based environment, in which their academic and social growth is facilitated by our staff. The schedule of activities and hands-on, active learning experiences facilitate the growth of children throughout their school day. Our teachers plan a wide variety of learning experiences for the children, encouraging them to explore and problem solve in a safe, nurturing and faith-based environment.

Our Curriculum

All classes incorporate time for free play, arts & crafts, circle/story time and recess.

Four-Year-Old Rising Stars Pre-kindergarten*

The four-year-old classes are designed to prepare children for kindergarten. The teachers create a learning environment that promotes the physical, social, emotional, and cognitive development of young children. Sadlier series, Discovering God curriculum introduces students to the Catholic Faith. World of Wonder of Wonder and My Math both by McGraw Hill curriculum supports the foundation for kindergarten readiness skills.

Drop-in care available in the mornings.

The class choices are as follows:

- Monday through Friday VPK only hours 8:30 am- 11:30 am
- Monday through Friday VPK 8:30 am –2:00
- Mid-August-June
- School uniform required

Three-Year-Old Shining Stars Program

The focus of our three-year-old class is for children to develop positive self-esteem and socialization skills in a Christ-centered literacy enriched environment. Children interact with their peers and learn how to be a part of a group, cooperate and share. Developmentally appropriate activities and weekly thematic units ensure children are at their optimal level of learning. Learning Centers incorporate time for pre-reading and pre-math skills. The Frog Street curriculum supports the foundation for the next level of learning. Sadlier series, Discovering God curriculum introduces students to the Catholic Faith.

Choices of hours are: 8:30-12:30, 8:30 -2:00 or 7:30-4:00.

Drop-in care for morning care and extended hours available to enrolled students.

- Monday-Wednesday-Friday, Tuesday/Thursday, or Monday-Friday
- Mid-August-June
- School Uniform required.

Our Curriculum



***Children enrolled in the three-year-old and four-year-old classes must be toilet trained and able to attend to their own bathroom needs independently before the first day of school. Pull-ups are unacceptable. Children are toilet trained when, without reminders; can walk independently to the potty, pull down their pants, urinate or pass a bowel movement, wipe/cleanse themselves without assistance and pull up their pants.**

**** ‘No Touch’ Policy: For the dignity and safety of your child, school faculty is not permitted to assist your child in wiping/cleansing urine or feces if they soil their clothing or when using the toilet. Your child will be offered a wet wipe. If this occurs, the office will contact a parent to pick up their child. If a parent cannot be reached, the office will phone the emergency contacts.**

Two-Year-Old Shooting Stars Program

This program provides a loving Christ-centered environment for children to begin their experience in group play and offers activities that will cultivate their natural curiosity and creativity. The Frog Street curriculum supports the foundation for the next level of learning.

This program is offered for children who are 24 months by September 1st. Diapers and pull-ups are accepted.

Choice of hours are: 8:30-12:30, 8:30-2:00 or 7:30-4:00 for Monday- Friday, Drop in care for morning care and extended day available to enrolled students.

12 Months - 23 Months Little Stars Program

The Little Stars program provides a Christ-centered environment that is nurturing and comfortable for you and your children. The staff creates a foundation of trust for which each child and parent feels welcomed and safe. Little Stars program staff will meet each child's level of developmental learning. Time is allocated for language development, exploration, outside play, music, early literacy, and arts/crafts. Curriculum – The Frog Street for toddlers.

Choice of hours are: 8:30-12:30, 8:30-2:00 or 7:30-4:00 Monday-Friday. Drop-in care for morning care and extended day available to enrolled students.

6 weeks-12 months Twinkle Stars Program

The Twinkle Stars program provides a Christ-centered environment that is nurturing, warm, inviting, and safe.

The staff prepares an environment that is comfortable and offers stimulating areas to learn, explore and develop. The staff will meet individual emotional, physical, and social needs of each infant. Cognitive and physical development is stimulated through interaction with teachers and others by exploring developmentally appropriate objects in the room. Curriculum – The Frog Street for infants

Morning Care, Extended Day/ Enrichment and After Care Hours

Morning Care

- Morning care is available for all classes from 7:30-8:30
- Advance notice is needed for morning care

Extended Day/ Enrichment

- Extended Day hours are from 12:30- 2:00 and available to the one-year-old, two-year-old, and three year-old classes. Class space is limited

After Care

- After-Care hours are from 2:00-4:00 for one-year old, two-year old, and three-year-old classes. Class space is limited.

Registration priority for the 2025-2026 school year will be given in the following sequence:

- Current full-time students enrolled M-F/ Current Enrolled students.
- Siblings of current students enrolled in PCAP or PCA
- Students of PCAP/PCA school employees
- Parishioner of Our Lady Star of the Sea (based on length of time as parishioner)
- Catholic Families relocating to our parish from out of town and continuing education for their children.
- All others include non-parishioners.

Supporting Parishioner are defined as those families that:

- Are registered Catholic parishioners of Our Lady Star of the Sea parish
- Regularly attend Mass on weekends

Our Resources



Spanish Education:

Our Spanish Preschool Class provides a fun and interactive environment where young learners can begin their journey of language acquisition in Spanish. This class is designed for children aged 3-5 years and focuses on developing foundational skills in the Spanish language through engaging activities.

Physical Education:

Our Preschool Physical Education (PE) program is designed to introduce young children to the joy of movement, coordination, and teamwork in a fun and supportive environment. Tailored for children ages 2-5, this class focuses on building foundational physical skills, promoting healthy habits, and encouraging social interaction through age-appropriate games and activities.

Music Education:

Our Preschool Music Class is an engaging and dynamic program designed to introduce young children to the world of music in a fun, interactive, and creative way. Aimed at children ages 3-5, this class encourages self-expression, rhythm development, and an early appreciation for music through songs, instruments, and movement.



Our Tuition & Fees



Registration Fee:

- \$250 per child for the one, two and three-year old is due in full at registration (annual non-refundable and non-transferrable fee).
- \$100.00 for the four-year-old with Aftercare is due in full at registration (annual non-refundable and non-transferrable fee).

Supply Fee:

- \$175 for one, two and three-year-old is due at time of registration and is non-refundable

Annual Safety and Security Fee:

- \$50 per family for one, two, and three-year-old is due at time of registration and is non-refundable.

Payment Policy

- All fees and tuition (10 monthly installments) are paid through FACTS. The first tuition payment is nonrefundable and due first week of June. All other tuition payments are due the first day of the month August through April. You may also pay your tuition for the entire year through FACTS.

Tuition rates are available upon request.
