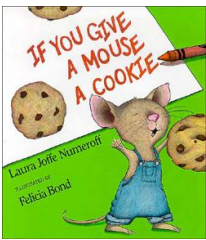
RISING FIRST GRADE SUMMER READING PROJECTS

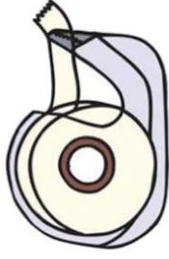

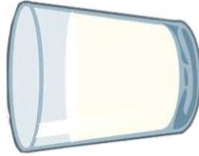
