RIISING FIRST GRADE SUMMER READING PROJECT

To help students maintain the reading skills they learned in Kindergarten, they should read every day. This can be a book they read on their own or one you read to them. A minimum of 20 minutes a day should be spent reading.

Required Fiction Book:

If You Give a Pig a Party by Laura Numeroff

Project: create pig face with a party hat using construction paper, paper plate, cardstock, etc.



Required Non-Fiction Book:

Ladybug by Gail Gibbons

Project: create a ladybug using a paper plate and include 1 fact that you learned from this Non-Fiction/Informational book on the back.
